


## Logos & Graphics




#### Logos at a Glance

## Signature systems

Signature Composition: Includes the Masterbrand Signature with the club or district/zone name.

Club Name: Use your charter name without repeating "Rotary," "Rotaract," or "Interact."

Alignment: Align the club name with the "y" in "Rotary" or the final "t" in "Rotaract" or "Interact."

**Logo Versions:** Use the simplified logo for sizes under 1.25 cm (0.5 inches) or for embroidery.

**District and Zone Logos:** Use these logos for district communications, placing the number below "Rotary," "Rotaract," or "Interact."





### Rotaract LOGO Template

In your logo, use the name on your charter or the name your club is known by in your community.


Because "Rotaract" is already in the logo, you don't need to repeat it.





Here, you can choose between a regular or simplified logo. Use the regular logo for larger items like banners and roll-ups.

Opt for the simplified version for social media posts, as "Rotary International" may not be legible on smaller logos.






#### COLOR

Here, you can choose the color of your Rotaract logo. Please stick to the three approved colors:

cranberry, white and black.

The recommended color is cranberry, as it best represents the vibrancy and energy of Rotaract.






#### ALIGNMENT

The logo is typically used with the club name below for a clean, recognizable look, but you can also add above (or you can use your district number above for distinction).

This layout ensures clarity and follows Rotary's branding guidelines.






#### **TEXT**

Use the name on your charter or the name your club is known by in your community.

Add only the name of your club, district, zone, or official Rotary entity to the Masterbrand Signature.

Use more than one name in a logo to represent a collaboration of many clubs






#### DOWLOAD

For optimal results, choose the right file format:

- PDF (vector): Best for print materials and embroidery for high-quality, scalable designs.
- JPG: Ideal for digital use, like websites and presentations.
- PNG: Use for digital purposes requiring transparent backgrounds, such as overlays on images or web pages.



This logo lockup can be customized for your Rotaract club. You can use your club logo and add text or a graphic identifying your partner, sponsor, program, or event.


#### When to use

Use a lockup to show a relationship between your club and its partner, sponsor, program, or event. Only one partner, sponsor, program, or event name or logo can be used in your lockup. This lockup should not be used as a club logo.



## LOGO ARRANGEMENT


Customize this logo lockup for your Rotaract club by adding your club logo and a graphic or text for one partner, sponsor, program, or event. This lockup illustrates the relationship with that entity and should not be used as a club logo.



## TEXT OR LOGO

You can customize it by incorporating your club logo along with text or a graphic that identifies one partner, sponsor, program, or event.


Remember, only one entity can be featured in the lockup.





You can add custom text, use the secondary Rotary logo, or upload logos for partners, events, or projects.


This flexibility allows you to tailor your branding to suit specific needs while maintaining alignment with Rotary's guidelines.





The secondary Rotary logo can include specific initiatives such as End Polio Now, People of Action, Rotary Youth Exchange (RYE), or Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA).

These logos help highlight our commitment to key programs and values while reinforcing the Rotary brand.




## UPLOADING PARTENER LOGO
